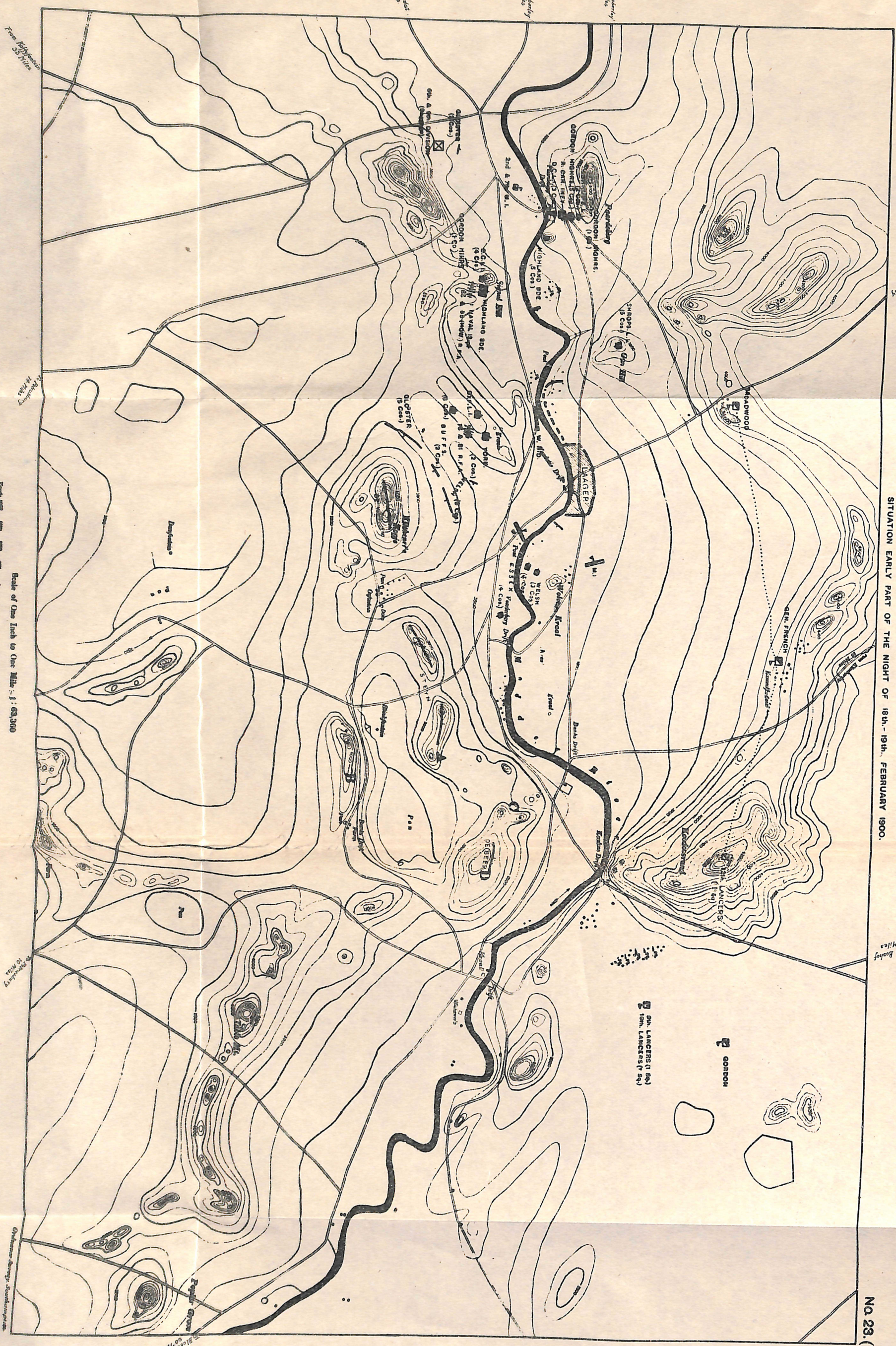


Scale of One Inch to One Mile : 1 : 63,360

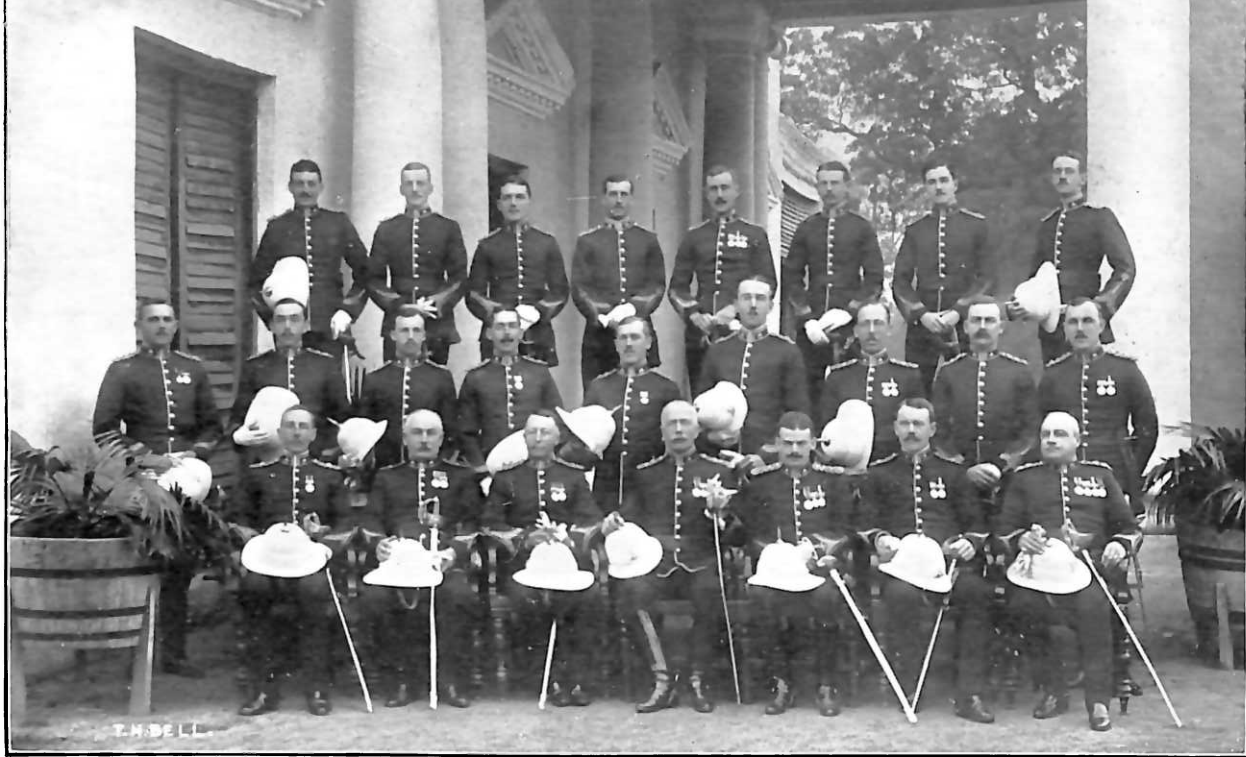
